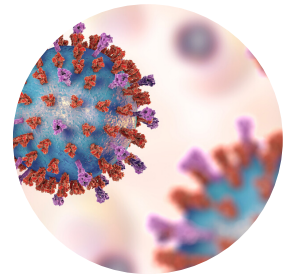


# NSBENDO Statement

## Coronavirus / COVID-19



### What about the new coronavirus?

With so many news stories, it's understandable to be concerned about the new coronavirus that causes COVID-19. Please know that the precautions North Shore and Brookline Endodontics already take every day to prevent the spread of infection also helps prevent the spread of COVID-19.

We care about the well-being of all our patients and staff - that's why we ask that all our patients follow these guidelines:

1. If you are ill with flu-like symptoms, you should reschedule your appointment.
2. If you, or someone you are in close physical contact with, have recently traveled to one of the countries with large outbreaks of COVID-19 (China, Italy, Iran, South Korea) or if you have been exposed to anyone who was diagnosed with COVID-19 or who was quarantined, please wait 14 days until you come for treatment to make sure you have not caught the coronavirus.

If (1) or (2) does not apply - there's no need to cancel your regularly scheduled dental appointment.
